Amend 2021-2022 District Calendar

Dr. Hector Martinez, Supt. explained due to the approval of the District of Innovation Plan the start date for student instruction can begin earlier. He is recommending the start date for instruction be Wednesday, August 18 instead of Monday, August 23. This will give the students three extra instructional days. Also, the County Livestock Show has been moved from the first week of January 2022 to the first week of December 2021. Therefore, the school holiday scheduled for Friday, January 7 has been moved to Friday, December 3. Ms. Locklear moved to approve the amended 2021-2022 district calendar as presented and recommended by Dr. Martinez, seconded by Mr. Williams and the motion carried 6-0.

Reschedule July Regular Board Meeting

The board members will be traveling to Fredericksburg for board training July 18-20. The regular board meeting falls on Monday, July 19. Dr. Martinez suggested the meeting be moved to July 26. Ms. Locklear moved to reschedule the July regular board meeting from July 19 to July 26 per recommendation by Dr. Martinez, seconded by Mr. Booker and the motion carried 6-0.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

ESSER II Grant Money

Dr. Martinez announced the district will receive in federal money \$1.17M through ESSER II Grant Funds. These funds are determined by the average daily attendance (ADA). The state will keep an estimated \$114,000 of the money and the rest will go to the district. The district must create a three-year plan outlining the method of spending the grant money.

ESSER III Grant Money

Dr. Martinez announced the district will receive in federal money \$2.6M through ESSER III Grant Funds. There are stipulations as to how a district may use the funds. BISD will follow TEA guidelines. One requirement is 20% must be used for learning loss which resulted from the pandemic and students learning remotely. BISD plans to use some funds to employ a math and reading interventionist and dyslexia interventionist, update technology for students, social and mental health support, reading academies, library learning centers and other areas.
